HOW TO GET INVOLVED

- 1** Direct questions about serving in a specific ministry toward ministry directors or church staff.
- 2** To serve in one of the ministries at Eastland, we ask that you be a member for 90 days.
- 3** Ministries involving working with our children require the completion of a Ministry Disclosure and Agreement Form and are subject to a background check. This form can be found on our website under the “Members” tab and will be completed every three years.
- 4** Those currently involved in ministry will be contacted by ministry leaders with any paperwork that needs completing.
- 5** Contact information for ministry directors can be found inside the church center app.

NOTES/CALLS – Notes include text messages, emails, and handwritten notes written to express care for other church members.
